



OUTCOMES MATTER

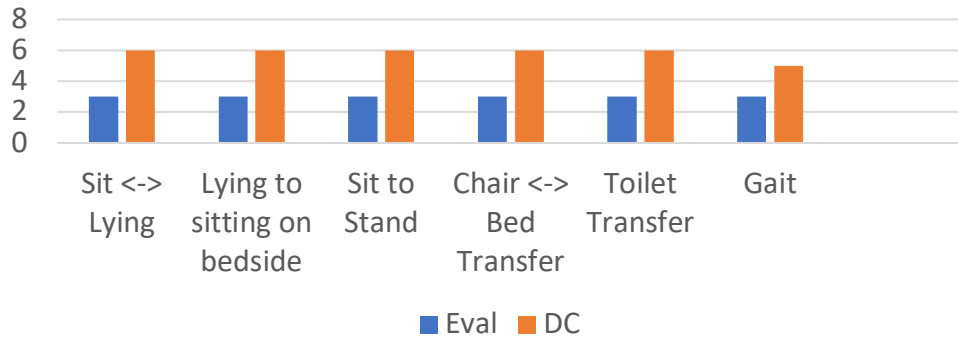
Ms. Ashleywishard is 76-year-old female came with in intertrochanteric fracture of the left femur after falling while trying to bring her groceries in. She was admitted to Park Manor of South Belt on August 31st, 2023.

Ms. Ashleywishard was evaluated by both Physical and Occupational Therapy. The initial physical therapy assessment indicated that Ms. Ashleywishard required minimal assistance for bed mobility, transfers, and walking. Occupational Therapy's initial assessment indicated that she required minimal assistance for upper body dressing and maximal assistance for lower body dressing and toileting. Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Ms. Ashleywishard who worked with both physical therapy and occupational therapy to obtain the strength needed to improve her independence. Prior to her hospitalization, she was able to complete all daily activities independently. Ps. Ashleywishard was very determined to return home with her husband.

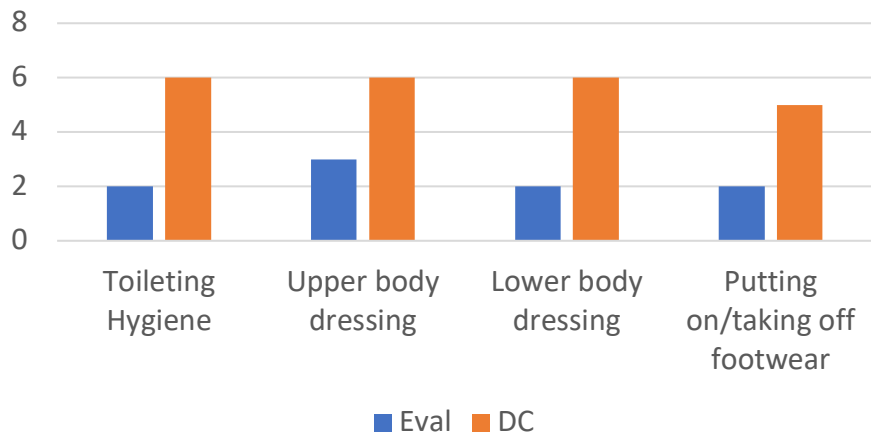
Ms. Ashleywishard participated and looked forward to therapy every day. She was highly motivated. She knew her goal was to get stronger so she could go home with her husband. She was always ready for therapy after having breakfast with her husband every morning. If Ms. Ashleywishard did not participate in physical and occupational therapy, she would lack coordination, muscle weakness, and be more dependent with her transfers, gait, and ADLs.

After Ms. Ashleywishard skilled physical rehabilitation, she demonstrates significant improvements in her functional mobility and ability to perform all activities of daily living. She was able to do all tasks independently such as dressing, toileting, and walking. Ms. Ashleywishard was walking over 300' with a rollator. Ms. Ashleywishard was able to be discharged from the facility after 16 days stay at Park Manor of South Belt and return home with the support of her husband. Most of all, Ms. Ashleywishard was highly motivated and happy of the progress she made at Park Manor of South Belt with the support from her awesome therapy team!

MDS Section GG Functional Scores

06 - Independent

Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper

05- Setup or clean-up assistance

Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.

04 - Supervision or touching assistance

Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.

03 - Partial/moderate assistance

Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.

02 - Substantial/maximal assistance

Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.

01 - Dependent

Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
