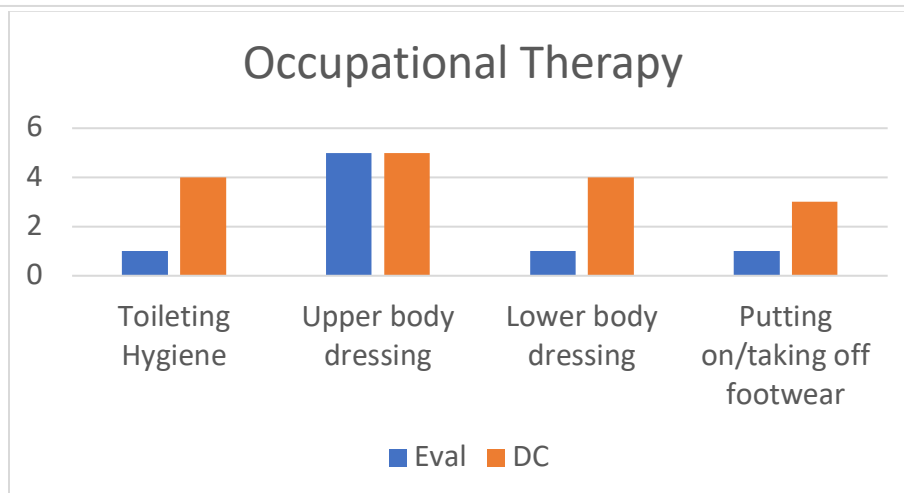
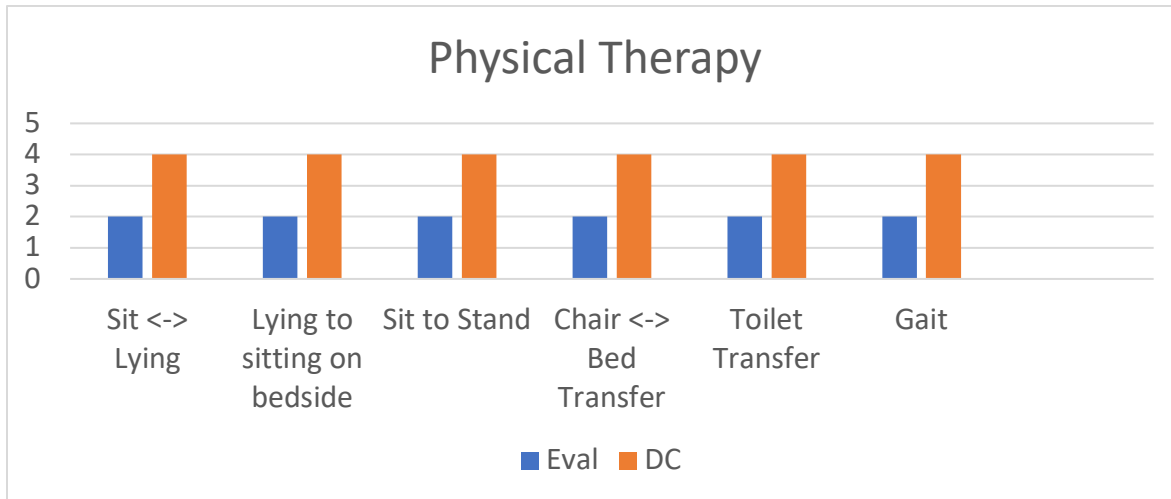


Mrs. Irene is a 57-year-old female that was diagnosed in the hospital with a right femur fracture. Mrs. Irene underwent surgery at the hospital for her right femur fracture. She was then admitted to Park Manor of South Belt on July 19th, 2023.

Mrs. Irene was evaluated by both Physical and Occupational Therapy. The initial physical therapy assessment indicated that Mrs. Irene required maximum assistance for bed mobility, getting from lying to sitting at the edge of the bed. Mrs. Irene required moderate assistance for transfers and moderate to maximum assistance to walk 5' with a platform walker. Occupational Therapy's initial assessment for upper body dressing was stand by assistance. Lower body dressing, toileting, and putting on her shoes was total assistance. Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Mrs. Irene. During Mrs. Irene's care plan, she said her goal was to be able to transfer to get herself to the bathroom. Ideally, she would like to get back to cleaning around the house again.

Prior to her hospitalization, she was able to complete all daily activities with no assistance. She was cleaning and organizing homes for a living. Mrs. Irene was very determined and told the therapy team she was not going home until she met her goals to be more independent. Mrs. Irene was always ready for therapy. When Mrs. Irene started to see how much progress she was making in therapy, she would encourage other patients in the gym and in group therapy with her inspiring story of her stay here at Park Manor of South Belt.

After Mrs. Irene's skilled physical and occupational rehabilitation, she demonstrates significant improvements in her functional mobility and ability to perform all activities of daily living. Mrs. Irene improved her ability for her bed mobility and transfers and dressing to stand by assist. Here is the best part, Mrs. Irene was able to walk over 200ft with a rolling walker with stand by assist. This was a huge accomplishment for Mrs. Irene! Mrs. Irene was able to be discharged from the facility after 16 days stay at Park Manor of South Belt and return home with the support of her sister. We are so happy and proud to have helped Mrs. Irene to achieve her goals!



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05 - Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
